

Winestyles Hosting Art Show

Winestyles is hosting an exhibit which will feature a variety of works created by artists David Hinnerichs Sr. and Isaiah Hinnerichs. Two special receptions, featuring art, wine and music, will be held on Saturday, Jan. 12. (The first reception is from 6 to 7:30 p.m., followed by another from 8 to 9:30 p.m.)

David Hinnerichs is a talented artist and fourth-generation cabinet maker who has worked on many impressive large-scale projects. Isaiah is also a talented artist and, at the age of 21 — in spite of his visual challenges at birth — has already received an impressive certification from the Foundation for the Junior Blind, Student Transition and Enrichment Program (STEP). He also earned an Outstanding Student Award from the Faculty of the

Visual Arts & Design Academy. Isaiah's artwork has been published in the Pasadena-based magazine "Volume," which is provided by the Pasadena Youth Center (PYC) and directed by Stella Robles Murga.

At this father-and-son exhibit at the Winestyles Pasadena location, both artists will present a variety of media, from oil on canvas or recycled woods to acrylic and sometimes steel. The simple and elegant style used by both artists may conjure a contemporary abstract landscape or a classical figurative still-life framed within a world of dynamic yet timeless space.

Following the opening reception, the exhibition runs through Feb. 25.
